

## SUPPLY LIST for CREATIVE CHAOS

The yardages listed below are just suggestions, since it will depend on the design you create. If you are interested in working on the Butterfly, please e-mail me and I will send you the yardage requirements for that project.

FQ background (I used orange on the square blocks & white on the butterfly.)

FQ leading fabric (I used cream on the square blocks & black on the butterfly.)

1 yard of your favorite fusible web with instruction sheet.

A variety of small pieces of fabric for all the applique pieces. Bring at least 10 to 15 different coordinating fabrics. These can be as small as 5" x 5" or as big as a FQ. Fat Quarter, Fat Eighths and even Layer Cakes will work. They can be lots of different colors, or work with a single color family. This is a great scrappy project!

Freezer paper

Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pencil, pins, etc.)

A Sharpie KING SIZE permanent marker

A rotary cutter, mat and ruler (you don't need a big one and you won't use it much.)

Most students can leave class with a block ready to stitch. **No sewing machines needed.**
